<u>Jurisdiction of Mumbai Cyber Crime Unit to investigate cyber crime</u> committed outside India

- 1. The Natural Sapphire Company through its Director/ Managing Director, Mr. Michael Arnstein has lodged the present complaint against Transpacific Software Pvt. Ltd. and its Directors, Mr. Prashant Telang and Smt. Swarupa Telang for the offences committed under Information Technology Act, 2000.
 - 2. As per section 1 of the Act which deals with its extent, commencement and application, provides that the Act shall extend to the whole of India and save as otherwise provided in the Act, it applies also to any offence or contravention thereunder committed outside India by any person.
 - 3. Section 75 of the Act which deals with offences or contraventions committed outside India reads as under:
 - "(1) Subject to the provisions of sub section (2), the provisions of this Act apply also to any offence or contravention committed outside by any person irrespective of his nationality.
- (2) For the purposes of sub section (1), this Act shall apply to an offence or contravention committed outside India by any person if the act or conduct constituting the offence or contravention involves a computer system or computer network located in India."
 - Section 75 takes a broader view on cybercrimes, committed by cyber criminals and the same is not concerned with the territoriality and nationality of cyber criminals. The Information Technology Act, 2000 has adopted universal jurisdiction to cover both cyber contraventions and cyber offences.

The essential ingredients of the above section are:

- (a) Any person, irrespective of nationality
- (b) An offence or contravention committed outside India
- (c) The said offence or contravention must have committed against a computer, computer system or computer network located in India or outside India
- 5. Prashant Telang and his wife are the directors of The Natural Sapphire Company. In the month of September, 2003, an agreement was entered into for developing software for the Company. Mr. Prashant Telang had developed software for the Company and was supposed to give the source code and transfer of projects to the inhouse programmers of the company. Transpacific Software Pvt Ltd had raised the invoices from its office from time to time and accordingly payment was made by Complainant Company.
 - 6. Prashant Telang is continuously attacking the website of the Company since last three years as mentioned in the complaint. Prashant Telang had embedded code in all the systems of the company from his office in Bandra, Mumbai. Recently (pl give details) Prashant Telang operating out of Mumbai has destroyed the database of the company. He has accessed the system of the company without its authorization. In spite of the complaint with the Cyber Crime Investigation Cell, Prashant Telang has not stopped his activities of destroying the website of the company.

7. Taking into consideration the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and in particular section 1 read with section 75, it is expressly clear that the cyber contraventions and cyber offences committed whether in India or outside India by Transpacific Software Pvt. Ltd. and its Directors, Mr. Prashant Telang and Smt. Swarupa Telang, are sufficiently covered by the Act. Hence, The Natural Sapphire Company, the complainant herein has the right to file the present complaint against Transpacific Software Pvt. Ltd and its directors.



ORAL ORDER

- This application is directed under section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code for direction to Cyber Police Station, Crime Branch, Mumbai to release applicant on bail in the event of his arrest in the crime that may be registered on the report given by Natural Sapphire Company.
- According to the applicant, he has not committed any offence and has been falsely involved in this case. He states that if he will be arrested then he will be loosing his reputation in the society and will be subjected to mental harassment and therefore, he prays for the directions to the concerned Police Station to release him on bail in the event of his arrest in a crime which might be registered by Cyber Police Station, Crime Branch, BKC, Mumbai.
- Perused the report filed by the concerned police station, from which, it reveals that the investigation is still in progress and no offence has been registered by the concerned police station. On considering the facts, the application deserves to be partly allowed in respect of directions to the concerned police station to give 72 hours notice (excluding holiday) to the applicant before his arrest. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- 1 Anticipatory bail application no. 171/11 is partly allowed.
- 2 Sr. P.I. of Cyber Police Station, Crime Branch, BKC, Mumbai is directed to give 72 hours notice (excluding holidays) to the applicant before his arrest in a crime that may be registered on a report given by the Director, namely-Micheal Arnstein of Natural Sapphire Company.
- 3 Applicant to inform this order to the concerned Police Station.
